




CSCS










Market Snapshot (2010 - 2014)

Legal Entity Identifier (LEI):



Commenced the issuance of Legal Entity Identifier (LEI) number having been appointed by Global Regulatory Oversight Committee (ROC) in August 2014 as a Pre – Local Operating Unit (LOU) through the Nigerian Security and Exchange Commission (SEC).

Services

Issuance of International Securities Identification Number (ISIN) code

Issuance of Central Clearing House Number (CHN) to facilitate easy investor identification

Providing online services to market participants for real time access to information with the use of authentication token: Registrars, NIBSS, Fixed Income Dealers, Stockbrokers etc.

Other Services: Collateral management (Pledges), Special account(s) and online services.





Services

Ancillary Services:



- ✓ Provision of platform for Market Makers (MM) to have access to Securities Lending Agents (SLA) for securities and cash: Market Making & Short Selling System; Margining
- ✓ Provision of platform for the movement of Bonds from Over-The-Counter (OTC) to Exchange platform and vice versa for the purposes of achieving retail Bond market, efficiency and liquidity

- Information Security System (ISS) monitoring tool against malicious threats

- Improved workflow and document management through the deployment of electronic M – File system

- → Upgrade of IT infrastructure (Acquisition of next generation Post-trade CSD System)
- ISO compliant Standards:
 Information Security Management System (ISO: 27001)
- → Establishment of Central Counterparty (CCP)
- → Direct Settlement System (DSS) for Straight through cash settlement of sales proceeds into the Investor's Bank account





Projects: Cont'd



- → Collaboration with National Identity Management Commission (NIMC) & Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN) to develop a robust a central biometric KYC infrastructure
- → Connection to the CBN Real-Time Gross Settlement (RTGS) system
- → CSCS participation in West Africa Capital Market Integration (WACMI)
